## Coaches and organizers must ensure:



## **Applies to training:**

- **1.** That the group's participants are informed about the content of the FIS Alpine Skiing Rules and other instructions for skiing in the facility. The requirements for good behavior with particular emphasis on sneaking, use of lift passes and use of correct entrances to the lift.
- **2**. That he/she assumes responsibility for ensuring that the participants in the training group follow the rules and instructions that apply to the facility.

Violation can result in the expultion of both individuals and the entire group.

## **Applies to training and races:**

- **3.** That existing safety measures in the facility will not be moved or removed unless this has been agreed with the responsible operations manager in the facility
- 4. That directions/instructions from the facility and the facility's employees will be followed
- 5. That motorized vehicles will not be used unless otherwise agreed in writing
- **6.** That errors and deficiencies discovered in the facility in connection with the training will be reported
- **7**. To have become familiar with the facility owner's responsibilities when carrying out organized training/races as far as this is concerned
- Protection against other skiers in the facility
- Securing the training/race area
- **8.** That the security measures to secure the training/run area vis-à-vis other members of the public are checked so that they function satisfactorily both before and during the training/run
- **9.** To have become familiar with the security measures that apply from the facility's side for the assigned training/race area
- **10**. That the route setting has taken into account the existing security measures and possible fall zones
- **11.** That the allocated training/race time is observed and that the facility is informed as soon as the training/race has ended
- **12.** That the training/race area is cleared as soon as possible
